**Requirements:** Current enrollment as a full-time undergraduate student in an accredited college/university in a declared bachelor's degree program and successful completion of at least 60 credits at the time of hire. Full-time undergraduate students who have successfully completed at least 30 credits and anticipate the completion of at least 60 credits at the time of hire may apply for this program. Authorization by the college/university for the student to participate in the program is also required.
