Gregory M. Lane Reappointed PA State Civil Service Commission

HARRISBURG (June 24) – Gregory M. Lane of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, was sworn in to serve a second term as a member of the State Civil Service Commission. The oath of office was administered by the Honorable Veronica Degraffenreid, Acting Secretary of State, Pennsylvania Department of State on Wednesday June 23.

Gov. Tom Wolf re-nominated Mr. Lane to serve a second term on January 25 and he was confirmed by the Pennsylvania State Senate on May 25. Commissioners serve six-year terms.

Commissioner Lane has served as a member of the Commission since 2014. He was originally nominated by former Gov. Tom Corbett and was confirmed by the Pennsylvania State Senate on October 7, 2014.

Mr. Lane possesses over 22 years of professional experience in various managerial roles with Price Waterhouse LLP, Royal Caribbean Cruises Ltd., and as Director of Human Resources at Aegis Group. Commissioner Lane has worked as a consultant advising small business on legal, financial, human resource and compliance matters.

The State Civil Service Commission (Commission) is a three-member, bipartisan, independent administrative agency responsible for conducting hearings and deciding appeals filed in disputed human resource actions (i.e., terminations, suspensions, furloughs, demotions, allegations of discrimination) and other employment matters. The Commission also performs high quality merit service and veterans' preference employment audits; and reviewing requests to exempt jobs from the classified service.
